Migration & Integration

- Promoting mutual knowledge and understanding;
- Promoting opportunities that could foster the dialogue between local communities and “new comers” (e.g. local events, festivals);
- Supporting language training;
- Promoting a culture of dialogue.

EU Cooperation & Borders

- Promoting a more united EU;
- Promoting more knowledge about EU countries to overcome wrong perceptions;
- Promoting opportunities of meeting and knowing other people of other EU countries (e.g. Twinning projects, school exchanges);
- Ensuring equal rights and the freedom of citizens;
- Ensuring a long-lasting peace.

Media & Euroscepticism

- Promoting tools and platforms for the identification of reliable sources of information (e.g. institutional websites);
- Supporting activities aimed at fostering the knowledge about the EU, its opportunities and institutions;
- Promoting digital skills (e.g. courses on “digital identity”);
- Promoting the dissemination of “positive information” (e.g. through a “European Journal of Positive Information”).
